

Phonics - Monday 1st March

Today we are learning... *ir*



Say the sound over and over for a whole minute. Can you: whisper it, shout it, use a deep voice, use a squeaky mouse voice, use a robot voice and a witch voice?

Activity 1: Write 'ir' as many times as you can in one minute. Don't forget to use your best cursive handwriting!

Activity 2: Circle the 'ir' in each word. What do you notice?
